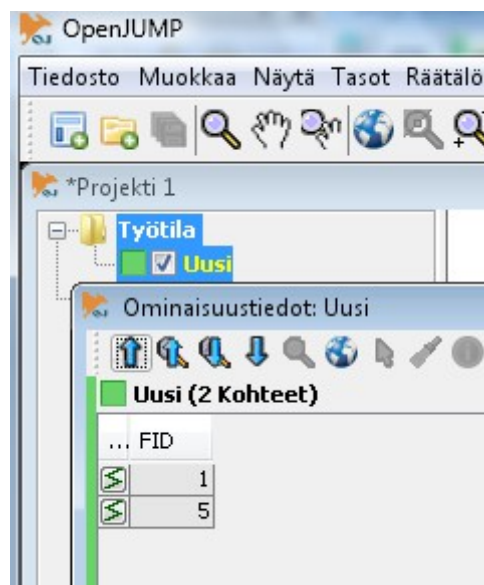
Draw line



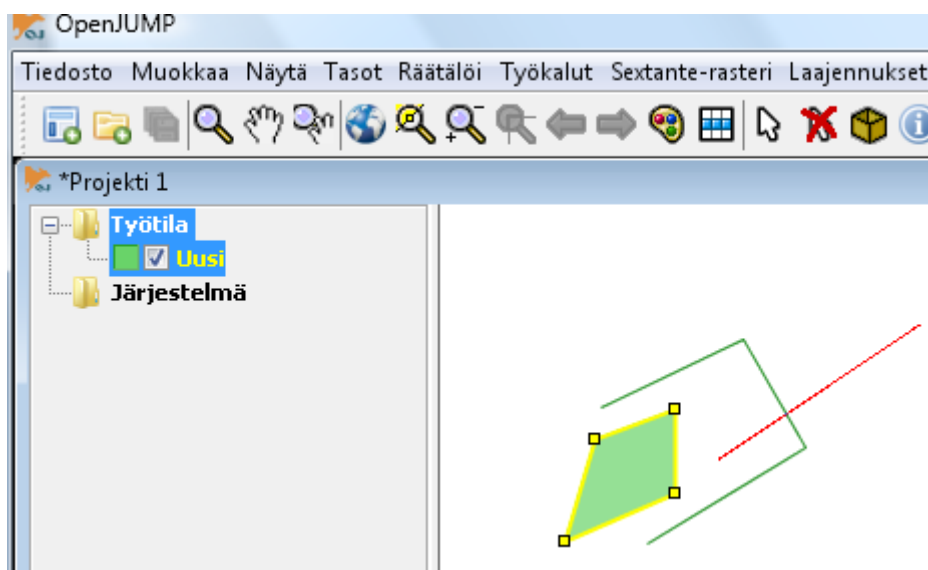
Show feature info, select and do Ctrl-C



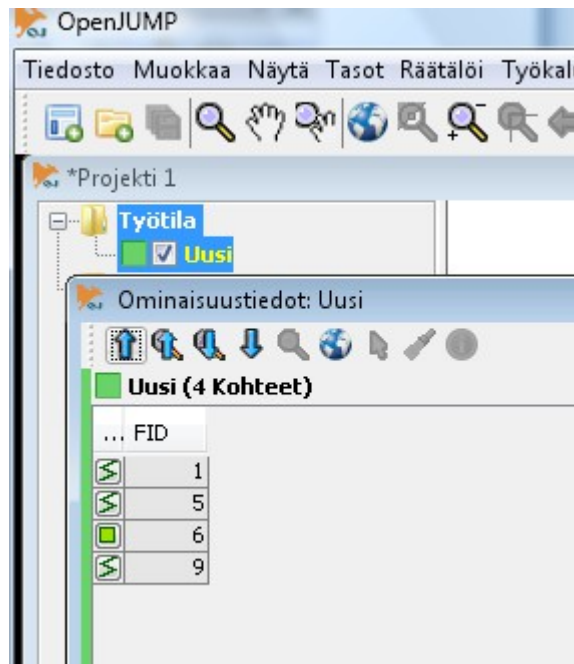
Edit – Add new features, do Ctrl-V and OK

New feature is created from the linestring WKT that was in the clipboard.

Reason seems to be that on Vista the WKT stays on the clipboard. If I do the same with Windows 7 (64-bit) and the same OJ and jre versions, selecting the polygon and doing Ctrl-C + Ctrl-V does not insert anything. If I copy the clipboard content into text editor I can see that the linestring WKT was still on the clipboard.
